We are excited to start our third trimester here at Amery Middle School. It's hard to believe that we are nearing the final part of the school year. In this final newsletter, I want to highlight a couple of upcoming events:



Forward Exam (Wisconsin State Test): Students will be taking the Forward Exam State Test during the month of April. All students will take a computerized Math and English Test, and 8th grade students will also take a Social Studies and Science computerized test. Testing in the middle school starts on Wednesday, April 2, and ends on Friday, April 11.

We are exploring ways to improve this event with our 8th grade student leadership team.





Vaccinations for 7th graders

Recommended vaccinations for 7th Grade students include one dose of Tdap (tetanus/diphtheria/pertussis) and one dose of a Men-ACWY-containing vaccine (meningitis).

Wisconsin State Law requires schools to have on file the recommended immunizations or a waiver. Waivers for personal or religious reasons can be signed by the parent or guardian.



Medical waivers must be signed by a medical provider.
